



CONTRABAND AND STORAGE INFORMATION

The following items are to be considered contraband. When they are found at the time of admission or during a luggage search, they will be confiscated and disposed of or stored until the patient is discharged. If they are found in a patient's room, car or clothing after admission, he/she may be subject to discharge.

CONTRABAND ITEMS TO BE DISPOSED OF WITH WITNESS:

- Alcoholic beverages or any substances that cause an intoxicating effect
- Non-alcoholic beer or wine
- Any illegal drug
- Drug paraphernalia
- Food
- Toothpicks
- Bleach

CONTRABAND ITEMS TO BE STORED IN LOCKED ROOM UNTIL DISCHARGE:

- Cell phones
- Wallets, money, valuables

UNACCEPTABLE CONTRABAND (NOT PERMITTED INTO THE FACILITY):

- Pagers/beepers
- Monitoring devices (police scanners, CBs, etc.)
- Cameras/video cameras
- MP3 players, iPods, tablets
- Straight razors/rug cutters/box cutters/letter openers
- Disabling substances such as tear gas, mace, pepper sprays or stun guns
- Incense/candles
- Fireworks
- Potpourri/scented oils
- Exercise equipment
- Lighter fluid
- Glue/nail polish/nail polish remover/white out
- Appliances (irons, blenders)
- Electronic cigarettes, vapor devices

- Computers
- Hair clippers/scissors/nail clippers
- Pornographic materials
- Aerosol sprays of any kind
- Hair spray containing alcohol/hair dye/hair color/color rinse
- Mouthwash and hand sanitizer containing alcohol
- Perfume, cologne, aftershave
- Bathing suits/short shorts/clothing with profanity, triggers or representation of the lifestyle of addiction (i.e. beer advertisements, nudity)

Any over-the-counter medication will be evaluated by the medical director for possible disposal.
